2.1 PRIMARY QUALIFYING PROCEDURES

- Primary Race Order Qualifying

- Open entries
- Each rider gets a practice session
- 1-22 Riders
 - One heat race (22 riders) all riders transfer to main, qualifying for gate selection only.
- 23-42 Riders
 - Two heat races per class (21 riders ea.) Top 10 qualify to Main Event, 11-21 transfer to last chance qualifier
 - One last chance qualifier top 2 qualifies to Main Event
- 43-62 Riders
 - Three heat races per class (2x21 riders ea., 1x20 riders) Top 6 qualify to Main Event
 - Two last chance qualifiers, top 2 from each qualifies to Main Event
- 63-82 Riders
 - Four heat races per class (2x21 riders ea., 2x20 riders ea.) Top 4 qualify to Main Event
 - Three last chance qualifiers, top 2 from each qualifies to Main Event
- 83-88 Riders
 - Four heat races per class (4x22 riders ea.) Top 3 qualify to Main Event
 - Five last chance qualifiers, top 2 from each qualifies to Main Event
- 89-110 Riders
 - Five heat races per class (5x22 riders ea.) Top 2 qualify to Main Event
 - Six last chance qualifiers, top 2 from each qualifies to Main Event

- Primary > Premiere Qualifying Procedure

- Top 22 from each Primary qualify for Premiere
 - Alternates taken in finishing order from Last Chance Qualifier(s) with fastest overall LCQ being first seed, second fastest will be second seed, etc.

3.1 CLASS SPECIFICS

Rules:

- In addition to these Supercross Futures supplemental rules all racing is governed by the 2021 AMA Racing Rulebook.

Eligibility:

- To be eligible to race in the Supercross Futures class, riders must be age and skill appropriate to the class they will be competing in and must hold a current AMA membership.

Road to Supercross through the 250 Futures Class:

Qualifying through the 250 Futures class

- 4 points required to earn license
- Riders must qualify and race at least one (1) Premiere Qualifier in order to earn points
- Points will be earned based upon number of entries scale below:

- 250 Futures points will be earned in a continuous 24 month period

250SX Class License Eligibility

Once a rider has qualified for their 250SX license through the Road to Supercross, the rider has two competition seasons to apply for their license before having to re-qualify. For example, a rider that qualified for a 250SX license during the 2020 Supercross Futures season may apply in 2021 or 2022.

In order to apply for your 250SX license after you have acquired the necessary amount of points, go online at www.amasupercross.com and click on the Online Registration and Forms tab. Riders that currently hold or have held a Supercross license in the past three competition seasons are not allowed to compete in the 250 Futures class.

AMA licensed riders not competing in AMA sanctioned events for a period of three years may lose their prior classification.

Applicants renewing a license that has been expired for more than three years must meet the present requirements for a Supercross License. This requirement may be waived under special circumstances through an appeal made to the AMA.

Transponders:

- Transponders may be required- refer to local Primary Qualifier track information. If you own a MyLaps compatible transponder, you may run your own, however you must bring it to registration to verify it works properly. If you do not own one, a transponder may be rented on-site.

Frame Number:

- The last 4 digits of the frame number on the motorcycle you will be competing on are required to register for any Supercross Futures Primary Qualifier.
